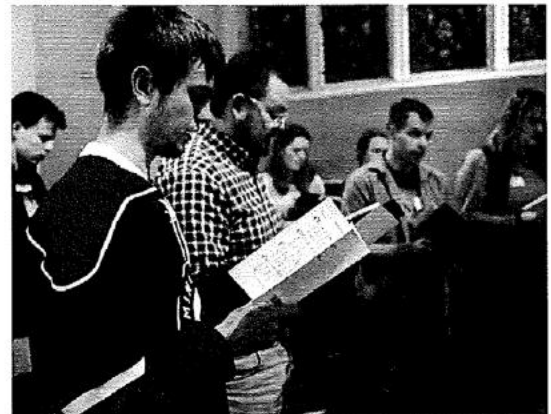

A MESSAGE FROM BISHOP MARTIN

To the amazing disciples of the Northwest Synod of Wisconsin,

As I reflect on this past year, one of the most significant moments came at the fall Conference of Bishops, which was held immediately following the installation of our ELCA Presiding Bishop, Yehiel Curry. In his first address to the conference, he talked about a one word focus for his first year, *connection*. As soon as he said it, I was already engaged, especially since that has been one of my goals in my first year!

As I tour this great synod of ours, I've already been to over 50 churches representing over 60 congregations. It helps a lot when I can experience a worship opportunity where multiple churches come together, as was the case Menomonie and Eau Claire! Needless to say, I enjoy learning about the history and more importantly, the people that each congregation has to offer. So distinctive, yet at the same time, we are all still a part of the same team, connected by our common faith and common mission to love our neighbors.

Speaking of our neighbors, I have made it a priority to lift up the important ministry of Neighbor to Neighbor, staffed by Deacon Lidix Montoya and supported by a newly appointed board at last year's synod assembly. It was at that same assembly where we adopted a resolution to raise \$175,000 over three years to support this ministry that is already making great strides in supporting the Latino community throughout our synod. I would invite you personally to contribute toward this goal and/or increase what your church contributes to this ministry on an ongoing basis. Neighbor to Neighbor is a ministry that is so critical right now as so many of our Latino friends live in constant fear of deportation, which can inhibit their ability to even worship in public! We have a tremendous opportunity to show them that they are loved and valued, so let's come together for this important purpose.

Another highlight of 2025 was attending my first ever Churchwide Assembly in Phoenix. In addition to electing the first black Churchwide Secretary (CeeCee Mills) and Presiding Bishop (Yehiel Curry), we also passed yet another social statement, *Faith and Civic Life*. The rostered leaders of the synod will be spending some time digesting it at our upcoming Winter Theological Event in hopes to equip them to lead a study in your church. I would strongly encourage you to participate in this study as it addresses many of our current realities, including the issue of Christian Nationalism. This is a strong movement that is sweeping the country, but remains largely in conflict with our Lutheran beliefs. *Faith and Civic Life* conversations can help us all remain rooted in our faith and help us understand how to be engaged in life beyond worship.

To close, I'd like to thank you for your relationship to the synod. We truly can do more together, staying *connected*. We cannot reach out to the many different groups throughout the synod without your generosity. May we continue to innovate in 2026 as we work collaboratively together and share the love of God throughout our communities!

"Come Home with Thanks Survey Results Summary"

The 2025 *"Come Home with Thanks"* survey reflects a strong sense of gratitude among respondents, who frequently mentioned family, faith, health, and daily blessings as sources of thankfulness, often recognizing God's presence in their lives. While some have not attended worship recently, the reasons cited include not feeling connected, health and mobility challenges, and discouragement caused by low attendance. Some respondents expressed a desire for more Bible stories in sermons and shared a sense of missing members who are no longer attending. Most indicated that adjusting service times would not significantly influence attendance.

Key recommendations focus on strengthening spiritual engagement and connection within the congregation. Respondents expressed appreciation for sermons that include more Bible stories to provide deeper engagement with Scripture, as well as the importance of personal connection through outreach such as visits, small groups, and flexible Bible study opportunities. Prayer requests centered on family health and spiritual guidance. Although the New Hope live-stream option is appreciated, many respondents emphasized missing the fellowship and sense of community found in in-person worship.

Women of the LEC Church 2025 Annual Report

Our Lydia and Faith bible studies met once a month to study God's word, grow in faith and trust the holy spirit to guide us in our mission as women in our church and our community. Our financial gifts are supported by our annual thrift sale, band concert, fall supper, quilt sales, bake sales and donations. Thank you to all who give of their time and talents to achieve our goals. Every Wednesday from September to May the women meet to sew and complete quilts, collect school supplies and complete school kits to be sent to Lutheran world relief. St. John's church of Eau Claire sponsored a Day of Renewal to gather and refresh our hearts and minds in Christ. A women's retreat in June at Luther Park in Chetek let us enjoy a camp like atmosphere. Outdoor fellowship with music, activities, a speaker of faith and fun. We continued our service of meals to the Cairn house residents the third Friday of each month this year and will continue to do so in 2026. We would welcome any volunteers to help us. Our fellowship together in our own community hosted a garden party, bean bag party, lavender farm tour and LEC church float in the Downsview day parade. The WELCA met twice this year in March and November with a business meeting and programs. I would like to thank the officers, committee chair persons, prayer chain members and bible study leaders and hostesses and communion volunteers for all your help this year.
